### 1.3. Internal Decision making and Coordination process

Based on situation report Executive Director will call an emergency meeting with Humanitarian Leading Team (HLT) within 24 hours of cyclone/disaster hit. In this meeting ED will activate Contingency Plan considering surroundings factors and situation report. Determine the response Plan and initial findings will ensure in this HLT meeting. In this meeting, discuss the staff deployment issues also. Discussion will complete the direction, how CHANDRADIP DEVELOPMENT SOCIETY -CDS will raise fund from Donor and AoB will discuss considering the needs and current conditions.

### 1.4. Situation Report (Sit Rep) and Needs assessment

- Based on radio, news papers and TV message tracking the situation of Disaster identification.
- Generates SitRep within 24 hours of heated disaster in the community and Information will collect from GoB and field observations
- Within three days update the situation.
- After 03 days start needs assessment.
- Conduct small scale needs assessment mobilizing institutional capacity.
- The information will be enough to mobilize donor funding.
- Chandradip Development Society -CDS will support joint needs assessment by affiliate partners and donors and utilizing staffs and volunteers.
- Chandradip Development Society -CDS will share information collected from different sources to the wider stakeholders as necessary.

### 3.1. Summary of Hazards of the Working Area

Barisal & Bhola District region are one of the most areas of cyclone and strong storm prone with tidal surge and salinity of water in Bangladesh. Tidal Surge and Strong Strom and Cyclone may affect in Oct-Dec, April-June and Saline water comes from the Bay of Bengal which has connected with River Meghna, Tentulia & Arial kha. Bhola and Barisal **Map in annexure** where we have indicated  with area are more vulnerable to the Cyclone and water surge.

The sectors of affect by Natural Disasters in Barisal & Bhola are the agriculture sector, Livestock sector, communication of roads connections, fishing sectors, constructions of educational institutions and human assets are collapses.

## **Section 6: Response Strategy and Resources.**

### **6.1. Strategy**

#### **6.1.1 Purpose**

Reduce the sufferings of women and children through complementing the GoB effort in supporting with Food and Non Food Items (NFIs).

#### **6.1.2. Engagement Criteria/Trigger indicator**

- At least 3000 HHs affected in the area. Or At least 1500 home/house damage in the area.
- At least 1200 HHs will be supported considering 6000 family members.

#### **6.1.3. Sector focus**

As per demand for intervention from the effected people side CHANDRADIP DEVELOPMENT SOCIETY -CDS responds subject to availability of resource from donor. Initially within 48 hours affected community primarily will be supported by CDS However, the response focuses the following matters for intervention:

- Support government efforts by providing dry food (flatten rice, Molasses, Biscuits and Puffed Rice) to the affected community.
- Supply safe drinking water
- Medical support with collaboration of government agency
- Temporary shelter (Tripoli/Polythene) support based on the need of the affected family where severe need of shelter.
- Hygiene materials i.e Soap, Napkin and Sanitary Pad support to the women and adolescent to maintain their personnel hygiene.
- Based on need in depth assessment at least 10 days food ration to the most affected families. Item includes the standard item for the each family. In special case cloth will be provided to the women and children.
- In case of rehabilitation focus will be given to the following initiatives;
  - Installation of Sanitary latrine
  - Tube-well maintenance
  - Core family shelter
  - House hold support
  - Livelihood support
  - Emergency Education
  - School repair
  - Water source disinfection
  - Agriculture input support

#### **6.1.4. Geographical coverage**

CHANDRADIP DEVELOPMENT SOCIETY –CDS performs its emergency intervention in its working areas on priority basis but can extend in other areas subject to scope of work. The area of intervention as per priority is given below:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Priority area: All unions of Bhola and Barisal District.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> priority area: Adjacent districts of Patuakhali, Jhalokathi & Barguna if donor requested for providing assistance.

### 6.1.5. Mode of operation

- CDS will operate directly or implementation through staff involving of CBO's specially women groups.
- At the time of affected peoples or HHs selection CDS will make sure the involvement of Local GoB (LGI). UDMC will involve in planning and in operational process.
- Existing Trained volunteers groups will be involve in the response process.
- Support will distributes at different points or pocket in one Union for convenience of the women and a children. CHANDRADIP DEVELOPMENT SOCIETY (CDS) will make sure the involvement of Women team in distribution of support process.
- Support can be consider more than one time based on the real situation.

### 6.1.6. Priorities groups

#### CDS priority groups in emergency response include:

- Women headed family affected in disaster
- Family having children less than 10 years
- Family members having disabilities and old aged members in the family will take under consideration.
- Pregnant mother, Children having traumatized in disaster within 8-13 years
- Single headed and old aged family will get preference.
- Ethnic group also be given high priority

### 6.2.2. Human Resource

Total 64 human resources of CHANDRADIP DEVELOPMENT SOCIETY–CDS and 40 nos volunteer have trained on disaster. Proposal writing skills have two staff. Ten staffs have trained on needs assessment, One Gender specialist. Two staffs are disaster & Climate Change Manager and expert, three financial Management expert, two monitoring and documentation experts.

CHANDRADIP DEVELOPMENT SOCIETY –CDS has 200 volunteers where women 75 and men 125. Rover Groups, One Public Health engineering, EFSL Coordinator trained on EFSL technique, two Agriculture experts.

Staff panel of CHANDRADIP DEVELOPMENT SOCIETY -CDS is ready and we will call at the time of requirement to response in disaster.

### 6.2.3. Logistic Resource

CDS has Ten Motor Cycles, 30 bicycle, One Engine boat or trawler with listed vendors for different logistics to supply in disaster or in any emergency. CDS has 50 vans and 50 rickshaws belong to HHs but can use in emergency time.

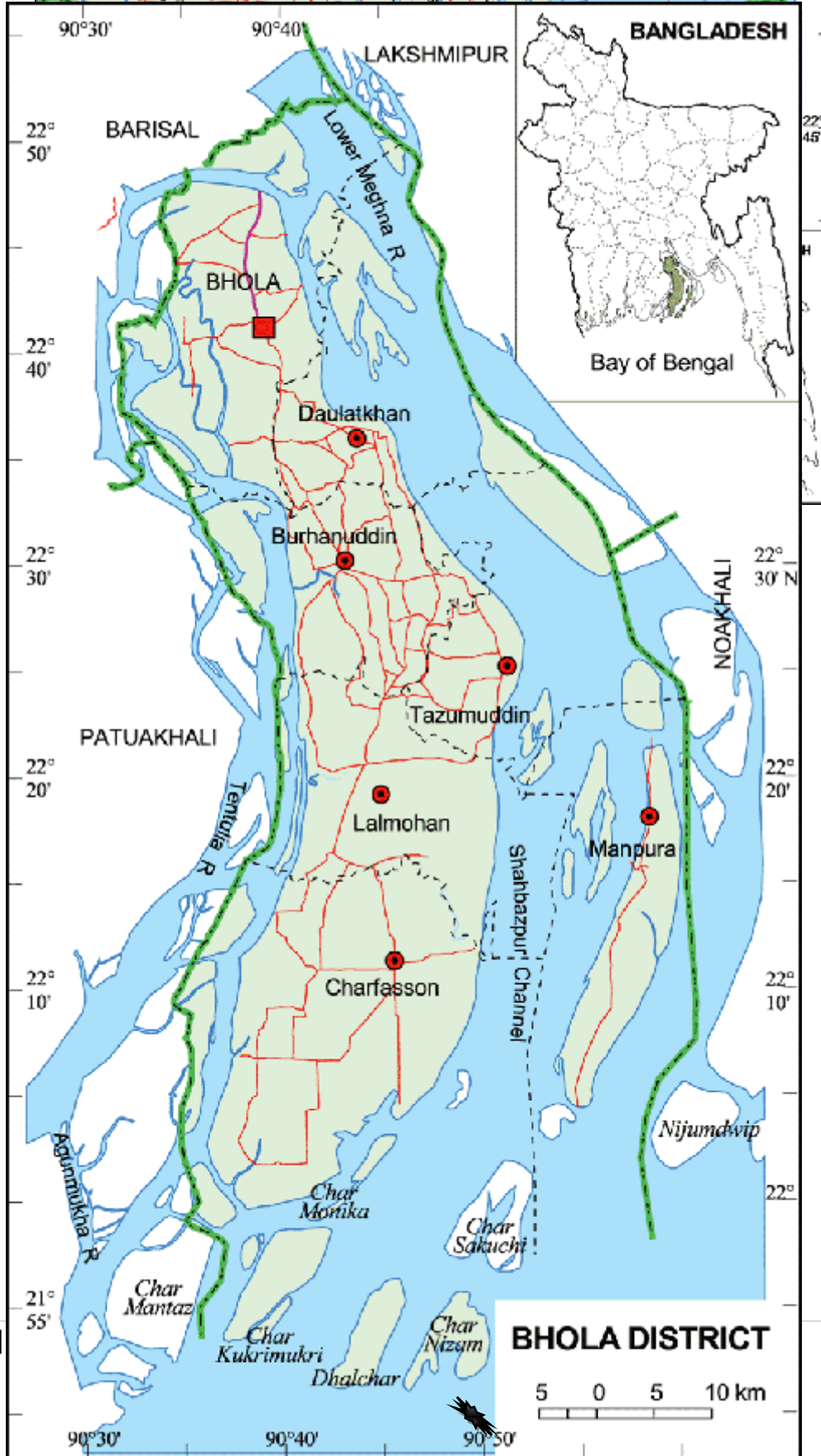
